

United Ontario Appaloosa Horse Council Club Rules

- 1. The United Ontario Appaloosa Horse Council (hereafter called the UOAHC) is run according to the Rules & Regulations of the Appaloosa Horse Club of Canada.**
2. Any problems or complaints **MUST** be taken up with Show Management **AND** the executive of the UOAHC.
3. Judges decision is **FINAL**. **No spectator or exhibitor shall approach the Judge for complaints or questions**. Any complaints or questions shall be taken to the Ring Steward or Show Management first. Any grievances to be handled as per ApHCC rule book.
4. The Executive and Show Management of the UOAHC reserve the right to excuse anyone from the show grounds who misuses their privilege of showing or spectating by abusing a horse or another person either physically or verbally.

Email to bakerjudge@aol.com Entries must be into Shannon Wednesday night prior to the show; otherwise a \$3.00 per class late fee charge will apply. No exceptions. No phone entries please.**
6. Proper show attire **MUST** be worn at all times including western/english hat, shirt, pants, breeches & boots.
- 7. All grounds and stalls are to be left clean & tidy, free of hay and manure.**
8. Youths showing in 10-13 classes or 14-18 classes **MUST** remain in that age division for the entire show. No cross entries. Should a Youth 10-13 wish to compete in the 14-18 age group, it will be decided by the Youth **AND** the Executive.
9. You **must** be a member in good standing of the UOAHC to win a Provincial Championship.
- 10. All exhibitors and horse owners must be a member in good standing of the Appaloosa Horse Club of Canada to compete at this show and to obtain National Points. Proof of ApHCC membership will be required as well as copies of ALL horses ApHCC registration papers.**
11. A Youth **CANNOT** show a stallion in any Youth class.
12. There will be **no** cross entering between Walk/Jog & Leadline. Youth showing in either may not enter any other riding class - except - Native Dress (if applicable).
13. Two authorized signatures must appear on all cheques and all major bills must go through a directors meeting.
14. Directors, Volunteers, Judges & Show Officials & staff of ApHCC **WILL NOT** be held responsible for accidents or injury or theft, to persons, animals or equipment while traveling to, during or traveling from **ANY** UOAHC event.
15. Rules are subject to revision by Directors.
